Minutes

Camden Town Council Special Meeting November 13, 2013

The properly called and advertised special meeting of the Camden Town Council was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President Richard Fite. Present were Members Jeff Sieber and Kandance Funk, Clerk-Treasurer Pat Casserly, and one guest, Jerry Snavely, arrived while the meeting was in progress.

A motion to approve the docket to pay claims associated with the HHIC Ribbon Cutting was made by Mr. Sieber and seconded by Ms. Funk.

The Council was given a packet on information on new OSHA labeling regulations for review and input on how certain matters are to be addressed. They were also given training material to read and become familiar with.

Other matter discussed:

- 1. Health insurance for the employees if the renewal date is changed from August 1, 2014 to December 1, 2013 the rate per month will increase from \$3661 to \$3899.13. If the renewal date remains August 1, the projected increase will be between 17% and 22% resulting in a possible cost of \$4466/month. Council voted to table this matter to the regular November meeting to allow time for proper consideration.
- 2. Council approved providing the lunch for the upcoming Rail Commission meeting to be held in Camden on November 18th.
- 3. Mr. Snavely had several issues:
 - a. Removal of trees in 2013 There is one, possibly two trees, for removal. Mr. Snavely and Mr. Fite will look at the trees and determine plan of action. Mr. Sieber suggested a tree be planted for every one that is removed.
 - b. Request for stone to be re-applied in a certain area between the sidewalk and street Council decision was to replace stone in this area only if the Town has done worked that resulted in the stone being removed. If the homeowner wants stone for their parking area, it will be their financial responsibility to purchase the stone and have it applied.
 - c. Salt and sand- Salt has been purchased and sand will be procured before winter.

- d. Roots in sewer lines Accu-Dig will be in next week to do some immediate work. Duke's will be coming in the spring for more extensive removal.
- e. Christmas tree donation The clerk-Treasurer is willing to donate a tree for in front of the town hall but Mr. Snavely raised the question of liability in removing the tree.
- f. Bids will be sought to micro-surface streets in 2014. If possible, funds will be encumbered from 2013 to help pay this cost.
