Downtown Revitalization Project

First Public Hearing

December 10, 2009

The properly advertised public hearing for the Downtown Revitalization Planning Grant was called to order at 7:00pm by Council President Peter Wagoner with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were Council Members Richard Fite and Andy Kelly, Clerk-Treasurer Pat Casserly, town attorney Anne Briggs and five guests.

Mr. Wagoner stated that this meeting was held to provide interest citizens an opportunity to express their views on the downtown revitalization project. A grant for the project was submitted but failed to be funded. A review of the first grant highlighted areas where improvements could be made but there are some scoring areas, such as "distress", that are out of the town's control. The project scope was reviewed by Clerk-Treasurer Pat Casserly who is also the grant administrator. The proposal will be submitted on or before January 8th, 2010 and the grant application is due March 19th.

RFQs for an engineer were advertised and one response, Municipal Civil Corp, was received. The packet will be reviewed and a determination on the engineer will be made at the year end meeting.
