## ORDINANCE # 2006- 1 PROVIDING FOR CLAIM PAYMENTS IN ADVANCE OF BOARD ALLOWANCE

## REPLACING RESOLUTION # 1992-A

The Town Council of Camden, Carroll County, Indiana, hereby ORDAINS that money may be disbursed from Town of Camden Funds for lawful Town purposes.

It is further ORDAINED by said Town Council that the Clerk-Treasurer of said Town may make claim payments in advance of a board allowance for the following expenses providing that each payments of the following expenses are supported by a fully itemized invoice or bill and certified by said Clerk-Treasurer.

- (1) Property or services purchased or leased from:
  - (A) The United States Government, or
  - (B) An agency or a political subdivision of the United States Government.
- (2) License fees or permit fees.
- (3) Insurance premiums
- (4) Utility payments or utility connection charges
- (5) Federal grant programs if:
  - (A) Advance funding is not prohibited; and
  - (B) The contracting party provides sufficient security for the amount advanced.
- (6) Grants of state funds authorized by statute.
- (7) Maintenance agreements or service agreements
- (8) Lease agreements or rental agreements
- (9) Principal and interest payments on bonds
- (10) Payroll

(11) State, federal or county taxes	
(12) Expenses that must be paid because of emergency circumstances	
(13) Expenses described in an ordinance of said Town.	
Notwithstanding the authorization granted hereinabove, said Town Council shall review and allow the claims/payments at the next regular or special meeting following the preapproved payment.	
This Ordinance replaces Resolution 1992-A.
