#### ORDINANCE 2011-1

# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS OF THE TOWN OF CAMDEN

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Camden ("Town") has previously adopted ordinances, including Ordinance 99-2, to establish and amend the rates and charges for the use and services rendered by the Camden Waterworks Utility ("Utility"), and:

WHEREAS, the Town arranged for the CPA and utility consulting company of O.W. Krohn & Associates, LLP of Westfield, Indiana to perform a rate study of the Utility in connection with additions and improvement being made to the Utility, and

WHEREAS, the study indicates that the current rates and charges for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks of said Town are too low and are insufficient to enable the Town to properly operate and maintain its waterworks plant, to provide for depreciation, to pay debt service on indebtedness of the waterworks and maintain a debt service reserve, to finance necessary extensions, betterments and improvements to the system, to provide a reasonable return and

to make payment in lieu of taxes, all as it provided for by I.C. 8-1.5-3-8 and the existing rates and charges should be increased; and

WHEREAS, the Town has conducted a public hearing on the proposed new Utility rates and charges and has determined that they should be established as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMDEN INDIANA:

- Section 2. All other non-recurring rates and charges shall not be changed and shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 3. The Town hereby elects to earn a reasonable return on the waterworks utility plant.
  - Section 4. The Town hereby elects to receive payments in lieu of taxes from thewaterworks utility plant.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
