WHEREAS the Town of Camden has a population of less than 3,500 and

WHEREAS in the past it has been difficult to find candidates for the Town Council from each district in the Town of Camden, now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Camden, Indiana, as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED pursuant to I.C. 36-5-2-4.1 that all Town of Camden legislative body districts are hereby abolished and that all members of the Town Council of the Town of Camden shall hereafter be elected at large.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall be effective upon passage.
