## ORDINANCE 92-3

## Amending Ordinance 1 Town of Camden Economic Development Commission

Whereas, the financing of economic development facilities and pollution control facilities for use by others is a public purpose, and

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Camden, Indiana, finds there is a need and that it is necessary to finance economic development or pollution control facilities pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Code.

Now, therefore, be it ordained as follows:

Section I. Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Camden, Indiana that there be and there is hereby created a commission of said town to be known as the Town of Camden Economic Development Commission.

Section II. Be it further ordained that said Commission shall consist of three members. The first Commission shall consist of one (1) member appointed by the President of the Town Council of the Town of Camden; one (1) member shall be nominated by the County Council of Carroll County, Indiana (the fiscal body of Carroll County, Indiana) in which said county the Town of Camden is located; and one (1) shall be nominated by the Town Council of the Town of Camden (the fiscal body of the Town of Camden, Indiana). The Commissioners shall take office upon their appointment, and their terms shall run the following number of years from February 1, 1982, following such original appointment: The Commissioner selected by the Town Council – two (2) years; and the Commissioner nominated by the Carroll County Council – one (1) year. All subsequent appointments will be for three (3) year terms.

Section III. Be it further ordained that said Town of Camden Economic Development Commission shall have the powers, rights and duties provided for under the provisions of the Indiana Code.

Section IV. Be it finally resolved that said act shall become effective immediately upon its passage as provided by law.
