## **EMPLOYEE**

Ordinance No. 97-4

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Camden, Indiana, as follows:

Commencing with January 1, 1997, if any employee of the Town of Camden is injured on the job which results in Workman's compensation benefits being paid, the Town will compensate that employee the difference between the amount that Workman's Compensation pays and the regular salary of said employee as determined by the salary ordinance in effect for the period of time the injury occurs. If the employee is off in excess of the time permitted by Workman's Compensation, then no benefits/salary will be paid for said excess time.

This Ordinance follows guidelines laid down in the March 1988 Bulletin from the State Board of Accounts, Page 3, based on an official Opinion by the Attorney General of the State of Indiana.
